PURPOSE OF POSITION

Carriageworks is now seeking Volunteer Invigilators for Daniel Buren's *Like Child's Play (Comme Un Jeu D'Enfant)*.

Volunteer duties will include welcoming visitors, ensuring high-quality visitor experience, providing visitors with interpretive information about Carriageworks and efficiently directing patrons throughout the exhibition. Volunteers play a key role in generating enthusiasm and a positive atmosphere for visitors. Volunteer Invigilators are part of the Carriageworks Visitor Services team and support Carriageworks in maintaining the safety of the public and security of the artwork.

INFORMATION AND INDUCTION

A full induction will be provided by Carriageworks Visual Arts Curator; Kelly McDonald prior to the official opening of the exhibition. This includes a full induction to Carriageworks and the exhibition itself. Onsite support is available during every invigilator shift across the duration of the exhibition.

It is of high importance when you are volunteering for Carriageworks that you are punctual. All volunteers are respected as a key component to our delivery team for each event. To support this all volunteers are expected to arrive on time and in a proactive way to build relationships and create a positive working environment for the rest of the team.

ABOUT DANIEL BUREN AND LIKE CHILD'S PLAY

'For me, colour is pure thought, and therefore completely inexpressible, every bit as abstract as a mathematical formula or a philosophical concept' Daniel Buren

Like Child's Play is inspired by German educational theorist Friedrich Wilhelm August Fröbels. Consisting of 100 blocks, arches, triangles and pediments, Buren plays with scale so that the objects, which, as children we towered over now dwarf us. Throughout his career, Buren has created artworks that complicate the relationship between art and the structures that frame it. His work questions how space can be used, appropriated, and revealed both physically and socially.

Daniel Buren is recognised as one of France's foremost contemporary artists, he has exhibited at the Venice Biennale, winning the Golden Lion in 1986. His work has been the focus of exhibitions at the Centre Pompidou in Paris and the Solomon R Guggenheim Museum in New York. Buren's career spans five decades of interventions, controversial critical texts, thought-provoking public art projects and engaging collaborations with artists from across generations.
